The Deichelmann Memorial Trust was established in memory of Samuel Mackall Deichelmann and Stephen Travis Deichelmann, sons of Louise and Major General Matthew Kent Deichelmann. Both Samuel and Stephen served honorably in the United States Air Force. The Deichelmann Memorial Scholarship represents excellence in merit, leadership, and service. This scholarship totals \$44,000- annual value of \$10,000 towards tuition and fees, \$500 annually to use toward books and a one-time \$2,000 freshman summer stipend to be used toward tuition or study abroad. *This scholarship is competitive and limited in number.*

Scholarship eligibility requirements:

- First-time Freshman admission to Auburn University at Montgomery
- Top 10% of graduating class (if this is not provided on your transcript, class rank will be confirmed by the University Scholarships Manager)
- Submitting an application to the AUM University Honors Program (apply at www.aum.edu/honors) is required.

All applications MUST be typed; **handwritten applications will not be accepted.** All submissions must be postmarked no later than March 1, 2025. The Deichelmann Memorial Scholarship is competitive and limited in number.
