AREA II (4 courses, 12 hours)

- 1.) Literature (Choose at least one):
 - ENGL 2530 or 2540 English Literature I or II
 - ENGL 2570 or 2580 American Literature I or II
 - ENGL 2600 or 2610 World Literature I or II
- 2.) 2nd Literature to complete a sequence **OR** Area II elective (if History sequence is chosen) *♦ (choose elective from approved list stars.troy.edu/approved_courses.html)
- 3.) Fine Arts (choose one):
 - VISU 1000 Introduction to Art
 - VISU 2030 or 2040 Art History I or II
 - VISU 2600 Intro to World Architecture
 - MUSI 2110 Music Appreciation
 - THEA 2040 Theatre Appreciation
- 4.) PHIL 2100 Applied Ethics

AREA III (3 courses, 11 hours)

- 1.) MATH 1050 College Algebra
- 2.) BIOL 1010/1011 Cells, Molecules, and Life/Lab (formerly called Principles of Biology I/Lab)
- 3.) PSCI 1500/1501 Introduction to Chemistry/Lab

AREA IV (4 courses, 12 hours)

- 1.) PSYC 1000 General Psychology
- 2.) History (Choose at least one):
 - HIST 1010/1020 World History I or II
 - HIST 1060/1070 Western Civilization I or II
 - HIST 2010/2020 American History I or II
- 3.) PSYC 2780 Human Growth and Development
- 4.) 2nd History to complete a sequence **OR** 2nd Area IV elective (if Literature sequence is chosen) *♦ (choose elective from approved list stars.troy.edu/approved_courses.html)

AREA V (4 courses, 15 hours)

- 1.) BIOL 2100/2101 Human Anatomy & Physiology I /Lab
- 2.) BIOL 2110/2111 Human Anatomy & Physiology II /Lab
- 3.) BIOL 3010/3011 General Microbiology /lab
- 4.) STAT 2670 Elementary Statistics
