

FRESHMAN LEADERSHIP SCHOLARSHIP AUBURN UNIVERSITY AT MONTGOMERY

Application Deadline: March 1, 2025

The Auburn University at Montgomery Freshman Leadership Scholarship program is a unique opportunity for driven students to develop leadership skills and gain valuable experience working with our-campus community. Freshman Leadership Scholars will participate in a semester-long UNIV course which will incorporate team building, communication, and shaping students to be future leaders. Freshman Leadership Scholars will be expected to work three (3) hours in an on-campus job which will foster work ethic and provide opportunity for collaboration with our faculty and staff. This scholarship is competitive and limited in number. This scholarship is a one-year award totaling \$2,000, and may be combined with the AUM non-competitive scholarships offered to incoming first-time freshman.

Eligibility requirements:

- First-time Freshman admission to Auburn Montgomery
- 20 ACT or 1020 SAT (not including writing portion)
- Minimum 3.0 high school grade point average
